



Some Common Hand Signals




Stop

Arm extended straight down
palm facing back



Slow down

Motion arm from extended out, palm down
to extended straight down, palm back




Speed Up

Motion arm from extended
down, to extended up and forward,
with palm facing up




Follow Me

Arm extended
straight up
from shoulder
palm forward



You Lead or Come Forward

Swinging motion in arc from back to front with palm forward pointing with index finger




Single File

Arm and index finger extended straight up




Staggered Double File

Arm extended with index and middle finger extended straight up




Pull Off / Pull Over


Motion arm from 45° position toward shoulder with forearm



Need Fuel
Arm extended to side
point to fuel tank
with finger extended



Hazard in Roadway
On the left, point with left hand
On the right, point with right foot
(Do not extend foot over the hazard)



Turn Signal On
Open and close hand with
fingers and thumb extended,
palm facing backward



Refreshment Stop
Fingers closed,
thumb to mouth
